A Serious Case for The Hollow Earth Brooks Agnew

Agartha is one of the most common names cited for the society of underground dwellers. Shamballa, its capital city, has also been referred to as the Forbidden Land, the Land of White Waters, the Land of Radiant Spirits, the Land of Living Fire, the Land of the Living Gods and the Land of Wonders.

Hindus have known it as Aryavarttha, the land from which the Vedas come; the Chinese as Hsi Tien, the Western Paradise of Hsi Wang Mu, the Royal Mother of the West; the Russian Old Believers, a 19th-century Christian sect, knew it as Belovodye and the Kirghiz people as Janaidar. In Asia, it is known by its Sanskrit name, Shambhala, meaning 'the place of peace or tranquillity.'

As you see, the religious and scientific idea of a hollow Earth has been around for centuries in exotic places like Scotland, Egypt, and Tibet and by 1692 reached notoriety with Edmond Halley's support. Once a popular concept, by the 1900s, it received little serious attention. Even though claims such as Admiral Byrd's flight, and rumors of a Nazi hideout were made, the theory was not supported by modern science.

Getting to the ClubHouse...

Southbound – Exit #227 (Candelaria, Menaul) stay on the frontage road for approx. 1.5 miles to Menaul. You will see the hotel on the right.

Northbound – Exit #225 (Lomas, University, Menaul) the frontage road for approx. 1.5 miles to Menaul. Turn left at the light, under the highway, the hotel is directly on the right.

Westbound – Exit #159D (University) right onto University, 1 block to Menaul, left onto Menaul, under the highway, the hotel is directly on the right.

Eastbound – Exit #159A (University and local traffic) at bottom of ramp turn left on 4th Street, approx. 1.5 blocks to Menaul, turn right. Go 4 blocks on Menaul, on left look for T-Mobile Offices, turn into their parking lot – go past their visitor parking into hotel parking lot.
